## 2019 Paso Robles Cabernet

**Appellation:** Paso Robles  
**Sub AVA:** San Juan Creek, Santa Margarita Ranch  
**Varietal:** 82% Cabernet Sauvignon, 12% Merlot, 6% Malbec

**ALC:** 14.5% **pH:** 3.86 **TA:** 0.56 g/100ml

**Barrel Regimen:** A portion of our blend is aged for 6 months in Blackletter Bourbon barrels with level 3 & 4 toast, from historic MGP Distillery. Bourbon barrels are made from new American oak & used only once in bourbon production. Repurposing these barrels lends an excellent depth of flavor when aging red wines.

**Tasting:** Rich and distinct with complex notes of blackberry, coffee, nutmeg, and caramel. A velvety smooth finish of plump dark fruit and spice flavors brought forth from added time spent in bourbon barrels.

The first vineyard in Paso Robles was planted in 1797, blazing a new path for wine in the West. Today, we craft our bourbon-barrel-aged wines with that same ambitious spirit of innovation.
