Tasting Notes: Aromas of raspberry, black currant and mocha lead into rich flavors of black cherry, huckleberry and dark chocolate. Rich and fruit forward, this juicy red blend pairs perfectly with BBQ ribs or grilled peach salad.

Winemaker Notes: The 2019 vintage in the Columbia Valley was shaped by cooler than usual weather, beginning with a moderate spring that led to a later bud break than past years. Temperatures throughout the summer remained temperate and mild. This allowed the grapes to ripen slowly and develop great concentration of flavor, while maintaining bright, balanced acidity.
