Tasting Notes: A beautifully aromatic red with notes of raspberry, sweet pepper and pencil lead. Scrumptious flavors of dried cherries and delicate notes of violets bring this wine together with well balanced medium tannins and a dry finish. Rich aromatic and fruitforward, this juicy red blend pairs perfectly with roast lamb with a rosemary and apricot glaze.

Winemaker Notes: The 2021 vintage in the Columbia Valley was shaped by record heat, leading to reduced berry and cluster size. Neutral oak was used to showcase the delicate aromatics already present in this wine.
